Visiting Faculty Details

- Program length is 2 months from mid June to mid August, however, accommodations may be made for faculty who wish to extend their appointment.
- Applications are considered on a rolling basis.

The purpose of the Visiting Faculty Program is to bring outstanding scholars to the Institute to expand and develop scholarship through the exchange of new ideas, cultures, and approaches to learning. Faculty with expertise in the following areas are encouraged to apply:

Anthropology, Biblical Studies, Christian Ministry, Christian Theology, Church History, Economics, Philosophy, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, and World Religions.



Visiting faculty will have the option of teaching directly from the Institute's list of courses or from a topic of special interest in their respective field. Faculty are encouraged to teach 2 to 3 courses and be engaged in faculty and student mentoring during their approximate 8 week appointment.

Additionally, visiting faculty will be assigned an Institute faculty guide who will provide guidance and serve as a resource during the length of the experience.

- Doctorate degree and relevant professional experience, or a Master's degree and relevant teaching or research experience
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills

- Housing on campus
- Food provision (3 meals per day)
