Environmental Internship Details

- Program length is 3 months from mid May to mid August
- Applications are considered on a rolling basis. Early applicants are encouraged and are given first consideration.

The environmental concerns of ACTS cover a wide range of activities. The Solid Waste Management Program collects, segregates, and composts waste to fuel our on-site biogas plant. The Waste Water Recycling Program recycles water through natural remediation and is made reusable for agriculture and the cultivation of aromatic and medicinal plants. Research is also being conducted on the preservation and revival of Mangrove trees and shrubs as a means of combating erosion and limiting the damage resulting from coastal natural disasters.

ACTS environmental interns will have the opportunity to work in the following areas:

- 1) Solid Waste Management
- 2) Waste Water Management
- 3) Aromatic and Medicinal Plant Cultivation
- 4) Mangrove and Estuary Management (Bay of Bengal)
