Healthcare Internship Details

- Program length is 3 months from mid May to mid August
- Applications are considered on a rolling basis. Early applicants are encouraged and are given first consideration.

Interns will work at the ACTS Health Centre & Hospital in Bangalore which caters to the medical needs of over 50 surrounding villages. The hospital's mobile clinic takes medical facilities to the doorstep of the rural poor who have no access to such facilities and cannot commute to city hospitals. Offering free and subsidized medical services, the hospital also conducts a number of programs to educate the rural poor on various aspects of health, hygiene, and sanitation.

Health Centre & Hospital interns will have the opportunity to work in the following areas:

- 1) Rural Medicine
- 2) Tropical Illness
- 2) Environmental Health Program
- 3) Public Health Management
- 4) Biomedical Waste
- 5) Medical Ethics
